159: (From his daughter Kualii's Probate 2166 (1st CC, 1872)):

Kahoohanohano died "before smallpox" [1852].

"After the death of the father Kualii was sometimes called

Kahoohanohano." She was married to Kinoiki at time of her death in 1872.

Her sister Namokuekolu, w., died in 1870. Her makuahine (aunt),

Kahanaukama's sister Kaoliko, and Kualii's husband Kinoiki were appointed administrators of her estate.
