\*Kaumaumakea was one of the kaikaina of Kuihelani, the steward left to malama Oahu by Kamehameha when he went back to Hawaii in 1796 (Kamakau, 1961:173). He is mentioned by K/A Kaapuiki in his explanations of landholders of Honolulu under Kuihelani (Kaapuiki Claim 3, NR 24.1 ff). Kaumaumakea appears in Marin's Journal under the name of Omomakea and Keomomakea (Gast and Conrad, 1973).

RP 4449, which had been granted to [K/A] J. Napahi. This piece sold for

payment of debts.

Probate 1839 becomes a joint Probate of Kapaakea and Keohokalole who both died intestate [Keohokalole dying on April 6, 1869]. Portion that

pertains to Kapaakea reads:

...the only real estate belonging to the deceased consists of a piece of land situate at Kamookahi, Waikiki, being the Kuleana granted to J. Napahi by R.P. 4449,\* and by him sold to the deceased containing 5 acres. It is necessary to sell the whole of the real estate for purposes of paying debts of the deceased. Above property was sold in five parcels to Richard H. Stanley, 2 lots; and F.H. Harris, 3 lots.
