159: Lot Kapuaiwa was the heir of Ulumaheihei Hoapilikane (died January 3, 1840)

PROBATE 2412 (1st CC) Kapuaiwa Lot Kamehameha died intestate December 11, 1872. His half sister Ruth Keelikolani, the daughter of Kinau (w) and Kekuanaoa, was declared his heir.

Kahoukua, a half brother of Kekuanaoa petitions that "he has been informed and believes that Luka Keelikolani is not the daughter of Mataio Kekuanaoa; that her reputed father was Kahalaia and her mother Pauahi, That Pauahi lived alternately with Kahalaia and M. Kekuanaoa without being married to either."****

July 28, 1873: Motion to take the above petition from the files: "as the petition now stands it is a (illegible) upon the title and a scandal against the reputed heir, and to contest the said petition, the testimony of very old and infirm witnesses will be required...."

September 11, 1873: "...The petitioner Kahoukua is the half brother of the intestate's father, His late R.H. M. Kekuanaoa by a different mother, ... H.R.H. Ruth Keelikolani is the daughter of the said Mataio Kekuanaoa and not of Kahalaia as claimed by the petition, by Pauahi, and therefore is the sole heir at law of the intestate. The petition is therefore denied."
